### **PUBLIC HEALTH SECTION**

#### **INSTRUCTIONS TO HOUSEHOLDS APPLYING FOR (VACUUMING) CLEANING OF SEPTIC TANKS AND CESSPITS**

1. Upon request of the driver, the householder must produce the receipt as proof of payment.
2. Adequate access must be made available to the vacuum tanker in order that your septic tank/cesspit can be serviced. The tanker carries a one hundred and fifty feet (150') hose.
3. The manhole cover of your septic tank must be unsealed before the tanker arrives at your premises. If your septic tank is sealed, the job will not be done.
4. A sufficient supply of water (at least one (1) barrel) if you do not have a pipe borne supply must be provided for your tank/pit to be vacuumed.
5. Your septic tank/cesspit will not be vacuumed if materials such as bottles, stones, rages, wood, newsprint etc., have been deposited in such.
6. Be sure that you are satisfied with the service before signing the job sheet. If you are dissatisfied report the matter to the Corporation immediately.
7. The job sheet must be signed by the owner or agent/servant present on completion of the service.
