All premises are to be maintained by frequent cutting of overgrown bushes and the clearing of refuse to prevent health hazards and injury.

Failure to comply will result in prosecution by the Tunapuna/Piarco Regional Corporation under Section 6 (i) of the Litter Act Chapter 30:52 (as amended) and/or by the Ministry of Health under the Public Health (Yellow/Fever) Regulations 1979 Section 11.

NB: Premises are subject to inspection by relevant authorities.
